SETTING UP TEACHERS FOR SUCCESS

The **Crowley ISD Center For Teaching and Learning** offers a variety of opportunities to help our teachers grow in their careers. We have a strong support system designed to acclimate and equip brand new teachers for their first year of teaching.

- **Mentors Investing in New Teachers (MINT)** is our mentorship program designed to support first-year teachers.
- **Newbie Network** training sessions are offered throughout the year for newbies and mentors to acquire and discuss pedagogical strategies.
- **Demonstration Classroom Tours** allow brand new teachers to experience live demonstrations of best practices in Crowley ISD classrooms.
- **Newbie Network 2.0** is a support system for early career teachers (in their 2nd or 3rd-year) that fosters continuous improvement through professional learning, collaboration and access to a variety of resources.

Crowley ISD also offers continuous professional development designed to provide opportunities in the areas of teacher leadership and aspiring administrators.

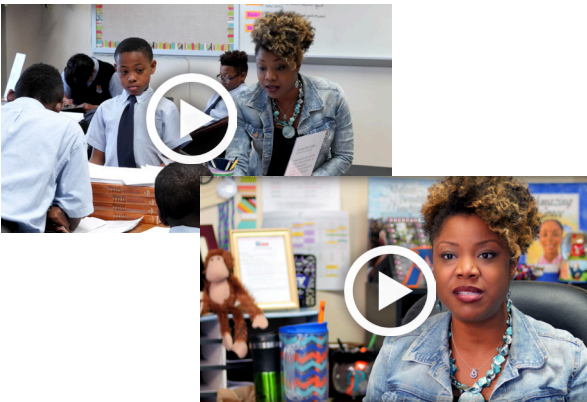


Professional learning in Crowley ISD is grounded in two beliefs:
